**Infant baptism:** The preparation course, under the keen eyes of Deacon Anthony and Alvaro, is still being done online and thereafter the families liaise with Fr Tony to make the arrangements. The first step is to contact Fr Tony by email and he will then refer parents on to start the preparation.

**Mass Schedule:** The changes in the Mass schedule will come into operation on **Sunday 1 August**. The main change is the loss of the midday Mass. The Mass times from 1 August will be on **Sunday at 9am, 10.30am and 6pm**. Currently, we are recording a Mass for the YouTube channel on Saturdays. When that arrangement changes, we will reinstate a Saturday evening vigil Mass at 6.30pm.

**Covid restrictions:** From Monday the legal restrictions on social distancing, limits on numbers attending church etc., will no longer apply, but we are encouraged to continue to exercise caution. After this weekend, there will be no further need to book in advance. Remember that next Sunday is our last one with Masses at **10am, 12noon and 6pm**. (See note above)
